
Dear Ms. Spencer:

In 1979 RSVP of Montgomery County began to develop its own Volunteer Impact Programs to address critical human needs in the region. With 1,200 volunteers, RSVP contributes over 100,000 hours annually to area nonprofit agencies and through its Volunteer Impact Program which has received national and local awards and recognition. RSVP calculates that over 6,000 individuals have received direct service through their Volunteer Impact Programs and an additional 94,000 have been served by RSVP volunteers through other nonprofit agencies.
